


BOARDMAN NEIGHBORHOOD NEWS

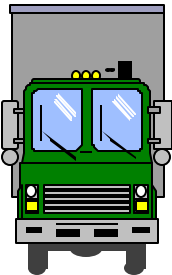
 Washington Street improvements (new water/sewer lines and curbs) slated for this summer have been postponed again until 2003.

The next Boardman Neighborhood Block Party will be held on **Sunday, June 2** on the 600 block of Washington Street.

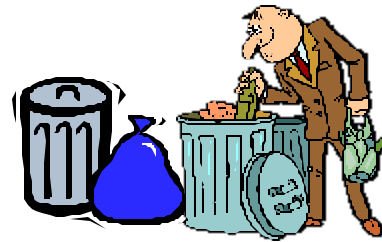
