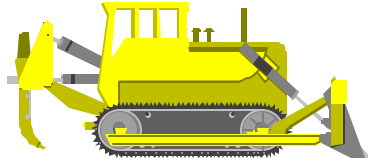


# Boardman Neighborhood News

Work is continuing at the intersection of Boardman & State and the end result promises to be both attractive and effective at slowing vehicular speeds as they enter the neighborhood from downtown.



On a related topic, the proposed stop signs on State Street at Park Street are currently under debate between the city traffic committee, the DDA and the City Manager. Richard Lewis will be doing a 90-day temporary traffic control order to determine what effects, if any, the stop signs will have. This will then be brought to the City Commission for final determination.
